Here are some ideas and activities to keep our Apple and Cherry children learning while they are at home.

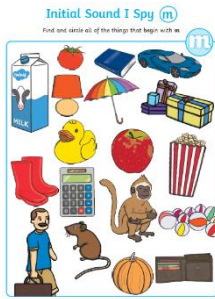
Reading and Phonics

- Check in your book bag and make sure you have read your **guided reading book and independent reader**.



- Play phonic **I Spy**. Have a look at the I Spy sheets attached - what can you spy which starts with the 'm' sound? Which pictures start with the 'n' sound? Now play I Spy with your family at home. Look around your home, what can you spy that starts with 'm' or 'n'?
- Go on a **sound hunt** around your home. Can you find exactly 3 things which start with each of these sounds? **s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g.**
- Watch **Geraldine Giraffe** learn the d sound at <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=65b3vEgskZ4> What animals can you think of that begin with the sound 'd'? Draw them.

Maths

Autumn Fun Activities

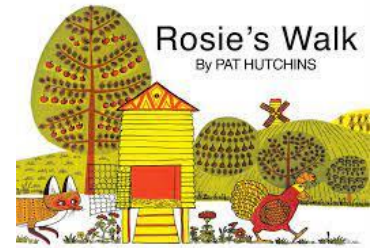
