










Stop, Look and Listen!

<p>English Our focus will be on the story 'Percy and the Park Keeper'. We will practise sentence writing, handwriting and continue with our phonics work. We will also continue guided reading in our new groups.</p> 	<p>Maths Compare and order groups and numbers. Recognise and count numbers to 10, forwards and backwards. Count 1 more and 1 less. Begin to understand addition, using number facts.</p> 	<p>Science Identify deciduous and evergreen trees and name the parts of a tree. We will be investigating the seasonal changes in autumn including the weather and changes to the length of the day.</p> 	<p>Geography Identify the physical and human features in our school grounds using simple aerial photographs and maps to represent and record those features. We will express our views about people, places and our environment.</p> 
<p>Religious Education Discuss why harvest time is special and look at how Christians celebrate harvest.</p> 	<p>Music Learn to keep a steady beat and copy rhythm linked to African percussion.</p> 	<p>Jigsaw PSHE 'Being Me in My World' To talk about working with others and why it is good to be kind and use gentle hands to keep everybody safe. We will work together to create a class charter.</p> 	<p>PE Games: Learn to master basic movements including running, throwing and catching and take part in fitness activities developing strength, agility and coordination. Games: Learn to dribble and pass a ball accurately, defend the ball and shoot with accuracy. Learn to play fairly and engage in a game of sport.</p>
