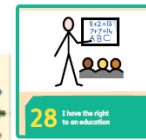






This half term we will:



<p>English We will explore 'The Baker's boy and the Great fire of London', sequencing events and developing sentence structure to include the conjunctions 'and', 'but' and 'because'. We will read a range of fiction and non-fiction texts about the topic and compare them, relating them to other texts that we know.</p>	<p>Maths We will develop addition and subtraction skills and use these to solve problems. Speed up recall of number bonds and number facts. Learn the value of coins and notes and use the symbols £ and p. Identify 2d and 3d shapes and describe them using their properties. Compare and order lengths in cm and m.</p>	<p>Science We will identify and classify materials; describe and compare them according to their properties; investigate how materials can change shape; consider and test the suitability of a variety of materials for potential uses. See Knowledge Organisers for more detail.</p>	<p>History We will learn about the Great Fire of London and how it changed the face of London forever. See Knowledge Organisers for more detail.</p>
<p>RE We will consider that life can be seen as a journey and discuss their journey through life to this point; talk about the Christmas journey and the story of Jesus' birth.</p> 	<p>Art We will develop a wide range of art and design techniques in mixed media by using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space. We will investigate tone, colour and texture and study and draw shapes from observation.</p>	<p>Computing We will continue to use computers and the internet safely and respectfully. We will use graphics and digital media to create simple images and animations, linked to our topic.</p> 	<p>DT We will design, create and evaluate a Christmas tree decoration; and investigate different sewing patterns and ways of decorating fabric.</p>
<p>PSHE We will learn to celebrate difference and to understand that differences make us all special and unique.</p> 	<p>Music We will continue to explore the African Drums with a teacher from Hampshire Music Service. After that we will be rehearsing our songs for the Christmas performances.</p>	<p>PE We are continuing to develop our fundamental movement skills in our 'World Cup Wonder' unit.
